His Beatitude Patriarch Daniel Ciobotea added to our Academy's large debt to him as host of our Colloquium, with a strong and lucid account of the promotion of the Word of God in Rumania by the use of modern media. He pointed to the very large use of television and various forms of electronic communication among the younger generation, just in the years when they are very impressionable. He also pointed out that the Church lives by the Word of God, that is, at its most profound point by Jesus Christ himself, mediated to us in the Church's sacramental life and the reading of the Scriptures. But the Church has in the past adopted and used new means of communication, and he cites the invention of printed books, the earliest of which was a Bible. This is a good point, and I would add that as early as apostolic times Christian literature was being published in codices (books with pages), instead of the scrolls which were at that time the norm for literature both religious and secular: that was one media revolution where the Church led and the world followed. Most of the Patriarch's chapter is a detailed account of the way the Church under his leadership has grasped the opportunities, through television, radio, and daily and periodical newspapers and magazines. We can admire this, and also learn from it. The Word of God is a communication from God to Man. The task of priests and theologians is not merely to analyse, understand and verify that word as our academic duty, but to see that it is effectively communicated to the heart of mankind, to which our Lord has directed it.
